## Parental Partnership

At Nursery we will be talking to the children about the story of  
“The Ginger bread Man.”

With your child please could you:

\* Make or buy some Gingerbread biscuits – encourage your child to smell and taste them. How do they taste? How do they smell?

\* \*to develop your child’s gross and fine motor skills use brushes and water to ‘create a Gingerbread man’ on the path or your drive way.

Use large paper to draw around your child and talk and add features, eyes, nose, mouth, buttons etc.



Talk about patterns. Go on a pattern hunt. Can they find a spotty pattern?

Go for a walk and collect some Autumn leaves, fir cones, nuts, sticks. Help your child to make a pattern.



Make up a pattern with actions jump, run on the spot, clap, repeat.
