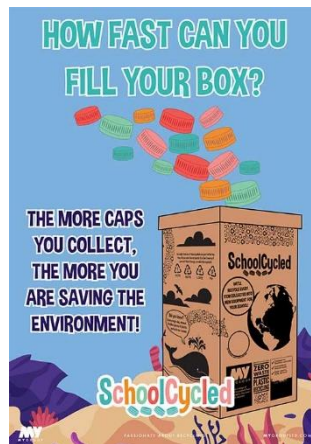


Parental Partnership



At Evesham Nursery School we are linked with the 'School Cycled scheme'-which recycle plastic bottle tops into a variety of different items that can be 'exchanged' for tokens e.g. child sized chairs, garden planters or mud kitchens. Please could you encourage your child and extended family to collect plastic bottle tops, during the Christmas break, and place them into the cardboard collection boxes that are situated around the Nursery. As you collect the tops you could:

- * *discuss the different colours e.g. red, green or blue*
- * *discuss the different sizes -using the mathematical language of size e.g. small, big or bigger.*
- * *encourage your child to count how many tops that you have collected. Help your child to develop good counting skills-by encouraging them to 'point and count' to each bottle top-giving one number name to each top e.g. "1,2,3,4,5.*
- **encourage your child to make comparisons when looking at your collection of bottle tops e.g "are there MORE red tops or blue tops?" or "are there LESS green tops than yellow tops?"*

**There will be a prize for the child that collects the greatest number of bottle tops-
