

Evesham Nursery School

The school will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Promote and follow the government's social distancing guidance; supporting children in an age appropriate way;
- Provide a curriculum that meets your child's social, emotional and academic developmental needs;
- Immediately contact parents/carers if a child displays symptoms of COVID-19 or is unwell in any way;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 and are sent home. If their test result is positive this will mean your child's 'bubble' and your household all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until your test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through text, email and the school website.
- Continue to plan home learning activities for those remaining at home.

Parent/Carer.....

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, Once tested I will let the school know the result as soon as possible via telephone;
- I will collect my child from school immediately; when requested to do so.
- On my way to and from nursery, I will adhere to the '1 metre plus' social distancing rules.
- Only one adult will collect my child. I will bring my other children only if absolutely necessary and keep them with me at all times when on the school site.
- I will only use public transport if absolutely necessary; if I do I will ensure I socially distance and wear a face covering as advised.
- I will be punctual and adhere to the school timings for my child. Staff will not be available to support late arrivals/ early departures unless pre-agreed.
- My child must not bring any items into school with them except for healthy snacks, a lunch box, cutlery if required, drinks bottle, suncream, change of clothes bag and a hat.
- I will clean my child's lunchbox on a daily basis, and I will pack items that my child can access easily, reducing the need for staff having to help e.g. open packets of crisps.
- I will ensure that my child changes out of their school clothes when they arrive home and their clothes are washed.
- I will teach my child about social distancing rules, realising that they are difficult to maintain for Nursery aged children.
- I will model and teach my child how to practise good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school and understand that communication will remain via text, email and by phone.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create a safe environment, by adhering to the Government's latest advice e.g. practising social distancing during gatherings.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents or carers emergency contacts details and collection arrangements.
- If my child is unsafe in school, they will be sent home and invited to return when a risk assessment has been completed.
- My child will be in a class group with designated staff.
- I will help my child to leave me safely, giving a positive start to their day.

I will do my best to:

- Follow my adults' instructions to keep me safe.
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only bring in important things, such as my lunch box, snack, suncream, hat and drinks bottle;
- Only use the resources and equipment which my adults have said I can use.
- Only mix with my 'bubble' to follow the new rules at nursery.
- Only enter and exit the school site by the designated gate; only enter nursery via my designated entrance.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or a tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene - use soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Wash my hands frequently throughout the day, when my adults tell me to.
- Try to not to touch my face or put any objects in my mouth and avoid touching my friends.
- Understand I am not allowed to bring toys or 'cuddlies' to nursery as they will increase the risk of germs spreading.
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I continue to make unsafe choices, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
