

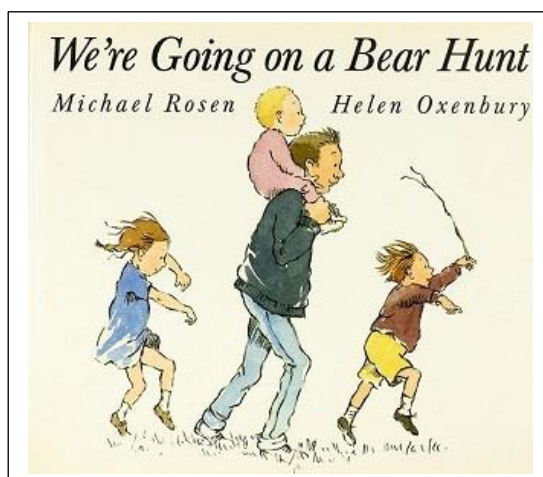
## Parent Partnership

### 'We're going on a bear hunt'

Read / Watch / listen to the story 'We're going on a bear hunt' by Michael Rosen – then go on your own bear hunt;

through long grass and mud, splash in puddles, explore in the forest etc.

Make a shaker at home – listen to a range of music and practise shaking and stamping along to the rhythm / beat.



Create a cave for one of your Teddy bears at home. Take a photograph and email it into Nursery to share with friends at school.

Play hide and seek – explore using prepositions 'in, on, under, next to, behind, in front of' to identify your hidden locations.

Use you senses when exploring the natural environment – looking, touching, smelling etc

Find out about different types of bears and the environments they live in.

Read other books about bears – 'This is the bear and the picnic lunch, This is the bear and the scary night, Where's my teddy?, Whatever Next?, Brown bear brown bear what do you see?,

Peace at Last, Goldilocks and the three bears. Talk about your favourite story.
